Nominees were submitted by the Nominating Committee of Gary Crockett, Tawana Carmouche, and Shannon Thorn. The election will not be conducted by ballot, and there will be no nominations from the floor if there is only one nominee for each position. No member is entitled to vote by proxy. Irrespective of the number of shares held by a member, no member has more than one vote.

In accordance with the Bylaws of Pelican State Credit Union, Article V, nominations for vacancies may also be made by petition. A qualified member may become a candidate for the Board by submitting the following three (3) items to the Nominating Committee Chairperson by the closing date of March 10, 2024. Item one, a signed certificate stating that if elected the nominee agrees to serve and fulfill the duties of the volunteer director. Item two, a biographical sketch of the nominee including a statement of purpose outlining personal characteristics and areas of expertise that qualify the candidate to be a Board Director. Item 3, the approved petition document signed by at least 1% of the eligible voting membership as of December 31, 2023 (500 signatures).
